SAMsARA Wine Company was founded in 2002. The winery name is a Sanskrit word meaning "the eternal cycle of life" representing "the eternal cycle that" "every vine and wine goes through in its lifetime." SAMsARA's philosophy of pristine and healthy fruit allows for a non-manipulated winemaking process. SAMsARA's fruit is grown in ¾-acre plots of personally selected rows in various Sta. Rita Hills vineyards.

Wine Making

An optimal growing site for Syrah and other varieties, Zotovich Vineyard is comprised of 35 acres in the northern part of the Sta. Rita Hills between Buellton and Lompoc. The vineyard is made up of mostly diatomaceous earth and sandy loam soils that create intense, mineral-driven wines.

TASTING NOTES


